



FISHING LAKE RULES

THESE RULES MUST BE READ BEFORE FISHING

OPENING HOURS - From 1st March 2022 7.00am daily. Closure times will be displayed on the gate. When the security light comes on, you have to be gone.

All fees to be paid on arrival before rods go in water via envelope system and posted in payment box. Failure to do this will result in double fees.

BUOYANCY RINGS ARE LOCATED CENTRALLY BOTH SIDES OF THE LAKE.

1. No liability accepted for damage, loss or injury to any persons or property whilst at Woodstock Farm/Park.
2. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children 10 years and under must be supervised by an adult one to one in the same swim.
3. Well behaved quiet dogs are allowed but must be kept on lead at all times and not cause nuisance to others. Dog litter must be bagged and taken away.
4. All non fishing visitors accompanying anglers are subject to a fee. Please see tariffs at the notice board.
5. No night fishing permitted.
6. Soft landing nets only, must be dipped before fishing and be of an adequate size.
7. Soft keep nets only, must be dipped before fishing and minimum 3 meters long.
8. No fish over 2lb to be kept in keep nets.
9. Carp unhooking mats must be used at all times and all large fish returned to the water as soon as possible.
10. All fish over 3lb must be handled with care, no higher than 2 feet 1600mm above ground level and returned to the water immediately.
11. Barbless hooks only.
12. No braided lines allowed.
13. Tiger nuts, dog meat and cat meat are banned bait.
14. Boilies are limited to hook use only.
15. Ground bait must be kept to a minimum (not tipped in lake or on bank.)
16. No pre-baiting prior to arrival.
17. Under no circumstances are rods to be left baited and unattended.
18. No fish are to be taken from this lake. Any person found taking fish will be prosecuted and banned.
19. No swimming in lake under any circumstances.
20. All litter must be taken home.
21. Disused lines, hooks etc must not be left in trees, grass and banks.
22. Noise level to be kept to a minimum so as not to upset others (no radios).
23. Only the brick toilet can be used by anglers.
24. Cars to be parked where shown and facing the field.
25. Cars left at owners risk.
26. Please respect all wildlife.
27. The woodland walk is not available to anglers unless staying overnight at Woodstock Farm/ Park.
